ITINERARY IN DETAIL

Day 01: 15 September: Arrive Delhi (Flight: AI 309 ETA 1715 hrs)

Upon arrival in Delhi, you will be met at the Indira Gandhi International Airport by a representative holding a "MW Tours" signboard. You will be escorted to your hotel and assisted with check in.

Overnight – Delhi

Day 02: 16 September: Delhi

Today's full sightseeing tour takes you to Old and New Delhi. Start with a cycle rickshaw ride through the lanes of Chandni Chowk Bazaar one of the oldest and busiest markets in Old Delhi. Photo stop at Red Fort, visit the Gandhi memorial at Raj Ghat, then continue to New Delhi past the India Gate and Parliament House to visit the Tomb of Humayun and Qutub Minar.

Day 03: 17 September: Delhi –Leh (9W 635, ETD 0540/0705)

Early morning transfer to the airport to board your flight to Leh. Arrive in Leh and transfer to the hotel.

Upon arrival today, it is medically mandatory that you relax and undergo minimal exertion to enable you to acclimatize to the rarefied oxygen levels at this high altitude.

Day 04: 18 September: Leh

After breakfast proceed on a gentle orientation tour of Leh. Our Leh City Heritage Walk ushers you to the labyrinth of the by-lanes of Leh City under the gaze of the imposing 17th century nine storied Leh City Palace. This walk takes you through this last big frontier town. The city boulevard presents a cauldron of shops which sell Pashmina shawls to Tibetan handicraft items. A few scattered curio shops also offer Tibetan silver jewellery and traditional Ladakhi jewellery set with turquoise, jade and emerald. Your walk concludes near Chubi village where your vehicle will pick you up and take you to Shanti Stupa, perched upon a great vantage point over Leh, with spectacular views of this mesmerizing stone strewn landscape.

Day 05: 19 September : Leh / Nubra Valley via Khardong la. 125km.

After an early breakfast, drive to beautiful Nubra Valley via Khardungla (Highest Motor able road in the World, 18,380 ft.) with the zig zag trail continues and drive till Hundar village. Afternoon enjoy the beauty of the sand dunes and optional ride on double hump camel.

Day 06: 20 September: Nubra – Leh

After breakfast drive to Leh via Hunder and Diskit Villages.

Arrive and check in at hotel.

Full day tour of the Leh Valley visiting Stock, Hemis and Thiksey monasteries.

Transfer to the airport to board the flight to Delhi. Arrive Delhi and transfer to the hotel.

Day 09: 23 September: Delhi – Agra (Train: 0810/0950 hrs)

Your journey today takes you to one of the Seven Wonders of the World, the Taj Mahal, and the symbol of eternal love of an emperor for his favourite queen. After being mesmerised by its beauty your afternoon continues to Agra Fort also known as Red Fort.

Day 10: 24 September: Agra – Fatehpur Sikri – Kalakho (04 Hrs excluding stops)

Today begins with an early morning drive to Kalakho via Fatehpur Sikri where you have the opportunity to look around this perfectly preserved abandoned city. Later arrive in Kalakho to experience a perfect organic retreat located in the rustic countryside surrounded by farmland. Then continue to the nearby village where you can see first-hand the everyday life of the village tribe.

Day 11: 25 September: Kalakho – Jaipur (03 hrs)

After breakfast your tour continues to Jaipur, the vibrant capital of Rajasthan also known as 'The Pink City'. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to begin your own exploration of Jaipur.

Travel to the nearby village of Nimaj, a tranquil hideaway in the heart of the Aravalli Hills. Check in to the charming Hotel Nimaj (Heritage), one of the oldest heritage properties in India. Enjoy an evening walk to nearby villages.

Day 14: 28 September: Nimaj – Jodhpur (02 hrs)

Your tour continues to Jodhpur. On arrival, settle in to your hotel before departing on an excursion to the nearby Bishnoi Village.

Day 15: 29 September: Jodhpur

Early morning departure for an excursion to Mehrangarh Fort, one of the most impressive and formidable structures in Rajasthan. Inside its boundaries are several palaces known for their intricate carvings and expansive courtyards. The chambers of Moti Mahal, Phool Mahal, Sheesh Mahal, the Sileh Khana and the Daulat Khana are noteworthy for the splendour and glamour of a bygone era. Later visit the Jaswant Thada and the Clock Tower market.

Day 16: 08 July: Jodhpur – Deogarh (04 hrs)

Today begins with a drive to Deogarh situated in the Aravalli Ranges. Later this afternoon enjoy a Rural Ramble - a jeep drive into the countryside with a guide, visiting small villages around Deogarh to take a closer look at rural life. Your day concludes lakeside with tea, coffee, and snacks while enjoying the wildlife.

Experience the surrounding landscape on a local train ride to the village of Phulad. Discover rugged, yet stunning views with an “in the middle of nowhere” feeling to it. Bookings

By making a reservation with Mandarin World Tours, you will have agreed to accept the Terms & Conditions. Please note all the bookings are subject to availability at the time of reservation.

Deposit & Payment:

A non-refundable \$400 per person is required at the time of booking when you select book the tour and a completed booking form should accompany your deposit. Receipt of a deposit will be taken as an understanding by MW Tours that customers has read and agreed to be bound by the terms and conditions in this brochure. Balance of payment must be received no later than **60** days prior to date of departure. Price shown are for payment by cash. An additional surcharge will be applied to the dollar amount paid by credit card or charge card. We reserve the right to cancel the booking without receiving full payment on due day and to apply the appropriate cancellation charges.

Travel Documents:

A passport with minimum of 6 months validity is required for passengers travelling to all countries in our programme. We can assist to apply tourist visa upon request and we cannot guarantee that any visa will be issued by the relevant authority and accepts no responsibility if a visa application is refused. If passports are not received by Mandarin world tours 30 days prior to departure, the urgent Visa processing fee is subject to be charged. Passengers should familiar with any visa requirements that may be applicable in the areas they intend visiting. Neither Mandarin World Tours nor your travel agent accept no responsibility for passport and visa requirements and clients should be responsible for all entries. Exits, health and other documents required by laws.

Cancellation Policy:

All Cancellation must be made in Writing to Mandarin World Tours and will be subject to the following cancellation charges from the date the written notice is received.

More than 60 days prior to departure, loss of deposit.

59-50 days prior to departure: forfeit 25% of total tour cost.

49-40 days prior to departure, forfeit 50% of total tour cost.

39-30 days prior to departure, forfeit 80% of total tour cost.

30 days prior to departure, forfeit 100% total tour cost.

If the airline ticket has been issued at the time of cancellation, there will be additional airline cancellation fee involved.

Amendment fee of \$50 per transaction may apply if you want to alter or amend any confirmed bookings. The airline penalties may also apply.
